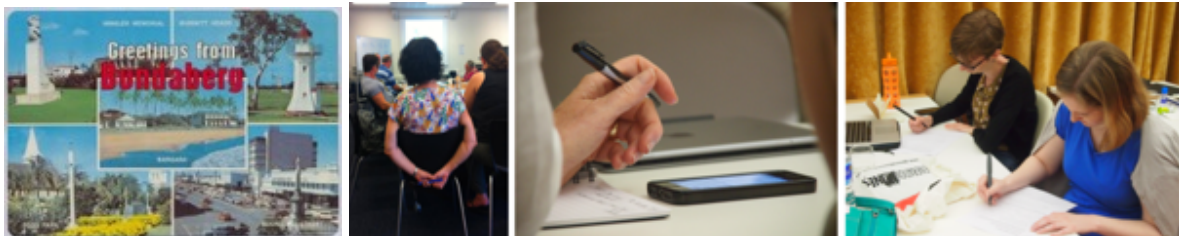


# Dispatches from Bundy
